# PHS Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes August 24, 2021

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on August 24, 2021 at the Perinton Historical Museum.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President Robert Hunt.

#### **Secretary's Report and Minutes**. Suzanne Lee

Minutes of the regular Board of Trustees meeting from June 22, 2021 were presented. *Minutes were accepted on a motion made, seconded, and carried.* 

**Treasurer's Report.** Linda Wiener

• **Treasurer's report for June 2021** was presented as follows:

**Balance sheet** – Total assets and equity = \$162,607. Total cash of \$55,463 (a decrease of \$224 from April and an increase of \$10,051 from PY cash).

Profit and Loss for month: net loss for May of \$234. YTD profit is \$8,066

**Profit and Loss actual compared to budget:** Year-to-date through August 31, 2021

Income \$22,688 compared to \$24,965 budgeted for 2020-2021 (91% of budgeted amount)

Expenses \$14,603 compared to \$24,403 budgeted for 2020-2021 (60% of budgeted amount)

Treasurer's report for July 2021 was presented as follows:

**Balance sheet** – Total assets and equity = \$167,267. Total cash of \$60,123 (an increase of \$4,660 from May and an increase of \$11,773 from PY cash).

**Profit and Loss for month:** net income for June of \$3,562. Net income YTD is \$12,728.

**Profit and Loss actual compared to budget:** Year-to-date through August 31, 2021

Income \$28,002 compared to \$24,965 budgeted for 2020-2021 (112% of budgeted amount)

Expenses \$15,577 compared to \$24,403 budgeted for 2020-2021 (64% of budgeted amount)

May's report was accepted on a motion made, seconded, and carried.

June's report was accepted on a motion made, seconded, and carried.

July's report was accepted on a motion made, seconded, and carried.
