The Perinton Historical Society began as a research organization founded by nine women in 1935 and was incorporated in 1950.

For over 80 years, documents, images and artifacts pertinent to the history of Perinton and Fairport have been collected and preserved. Many items in the collections date back to the mid-19th century and are found nowhere else.



Mission, Vision and Goals

The mission of the Society is to promote interest in preserving and sharing local history. The vision is to be the leading, widely recognized community resource for promoting and instilling a sense of local history among Perinton residents.

Two key goals are to operate the Museum using the American Museum Association's standards and to enhance the collections by focusing primarily on acquiring items associated with Perinton and Fairport during the 19th and 20th centuries.

Collections include resources on domestic life, farming, genealogy, canal development, structures, and industry.
